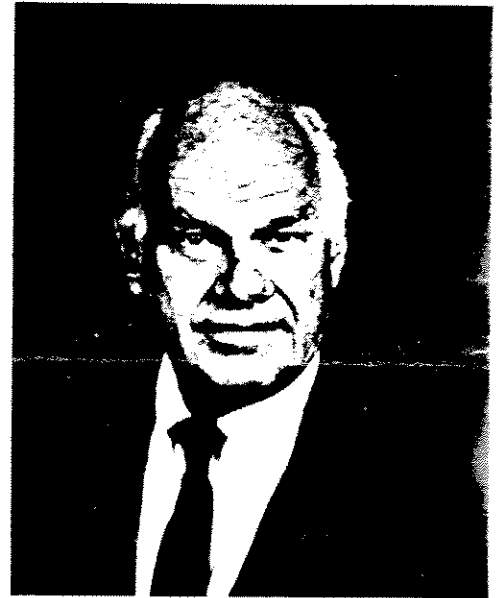

Mr. Akin's professional expertise is in civil litigation with a special emphasis in cases involving catastrophic losses. He has participated in cases arising out of the uranium tailings spill at Churchrock, the botulism outbreak in Clovis and the mercury poisoning of a family in Alamogordo. He has practiced

extensively in both state and federal courts and successfully argued the landmark case of *Aetna v. U.S.* before the Supreme Court of the United States.

Mr. Akin is a member of the Albuquerque, the New Mexico and the American Bar Associations. He was a co-founder of

the Medical-Legal Malpractice Panel which received national recognition and has become a part of the statutory law of New Mexico. He is past president of the Albuquerque Lawyers Club and was a State Bar Commissioner from 1975-1978.
