**AGENDA ITEM 2: Approval of minutes from last meeting**

Discussion regarding approval of minutes. Rita joined the meeting at 12:13, establishing a quorum. Charles moved approval, Greg seconded. All approved.

**AGENDA ITEM 3: Reports of the Liasons**

Re: Newsletter, Blog, website ideas – The subcommittee has not met. The ideas are preliminary and it appears the Employment Law section is the only section considering the idea of a blog. Christine reports that the State Bar is looking at developing policies and procedures for implementing new information distribution ideas like blogs. considering a National speaker, and they will extend an invite to an EEO Commissioner.
