**2011 NMWBA Bar Scholarship Application**

**PURPOSE**

The New Mexico Women's Bar Association will award up to four (4) scholarships to students who are graduating from the University of New Mexico School of Law in May 2011. The purpose of these scholarships is to help the graduates enroll in courses for bar examination preparation. Each scholarship will not exceed \$1,500. Members of the Board of Directors of the New Mexico Women's Bar Association will review the applications and will consider the following factors in awarding the scholarships: (1) financial need and (2) academic achievement. The scholarships will provide reimbursement up to \$1,500 for the cost of bar examination preparation classes, including but not limited to BarBri and PMBR.
