Mediators and arbitrators must be active members of the State Bar, and either trained in mediation or arbitration, or willing to receive training. *Trainings will be MCLE accredited.*

The Consumer-Business Dispute Mediation Program is a statewide program designed to resolve disputes between consumers and businesses of \$25,000 or less. Volunteer mediators and arbitrators will be assigned cases that have not been resolved by initial efforts of the BBB and can reasonably be resolved in a single hearing.
