If you're looking for a State Bar publication and need to reference it again, then look to the State Bar Web site as your source. The *Bar Bulletin*, the *New Mexico Lawyer*, and division, section, and committee publications are available on the Web, not to mention reports, surveys and other special publications.

- The *Bar Bulletin* is accessed through the Attorneys/Members navigation menu on the home page. The Web version of this publication does not include court opinions; however, a direct link is provided to the N.M. Supreme Court Web site where all published opinions are available. Every weekly issue is available, along with archived issues dating from 2005. The Web version is in full color, and members can also opt to subscribe to the electronic version (also in color) via e-mail instead of receiving a printed copy. Visit the Web site if you are interested in this option. Information on how to submit notices, announcements and advertising is also provided.

- The *New Mexico Lawyer*, a quarterly insert in the *Bar Bulletin*, is available as a stand-alone publication on the Web as well. Each issue focuses on a single topic of current interest to a broad segment of the legal community. Submissions and ideas for topics are always welcome. Issues are available from 2006.

- Division Publications: The Young Lawyers Division archives *In Brief*, with issues dating back to 2000. This publication provides information to members who are new to the profession or who meet a certain age requirement. The Paralegal Division uploads *Focus*, with information specific to paralegals. The Senior Lawyers Division's *Closing a Law Office: New Mexico Guide for a Third Party Closer* is available as well.
