



## **DIVISIONS PROVIDE VALUABLE INFORMATION AND RESOURCES ON THE STATE BAR WEB SITE**

The Paralegal Division, Senior Lawyers Division, and Young Lawyers Division have expanded the information and resources available online and have a distinct presence on the State Bar Web site.

### **Paralegal Division**

Information is provided on the role of a paralegal and the organization and purpose of the division. The board, officers and various committees of the division are listed, along with the bylaws, code of ethics, rules governing paralegal services, and MCLE requirements. The site lists CLE programs that the division sponsors in addition to the Job Bank, where paralegal and legal assistant positions are posted. A membership directory and a record of CLE credits earned by members is updated monthly. Division publications are also available.

### **Senior Lawyers Division**

The Senior Lawyers Division promotes the special interests of senior lawyers with programs and activities of interest to members who are fifty-five or older and who have practiced law for 25 years or more. The board and officers along with the bylaws are listed. Publications that the division has sponsored are also available. In addition, the Oral History Project, sponsored by the division, provides biographical information on senior lawyers.

### **Young Lawyers Division**

The Young Lawyers Division reaches out to members who are under the age of 36, as well as to members who have practiced law five years or less. The board, officers, bylaws, and division activities are listed, such as: the mentorship program, Ask-a-Lawyer, Bar Exam Orientation, Choose Law, the Homeless Legal Clinic, Junior Judges, Justice for All Ball, brown-bag luncheons, and other activities co-sponsored with the UNM School of Law. The site also includes newsletters that are published by the division.
