Appointment of Young Lawyer Delegate to ABA House of Delegates

The Board of Bar Commissioners will make one appointment of a young lawyer delegate to the American Bar Association (ABA) House of Delegates (HOD) for a two-year term, which will begin at the conclusion of the 2017 ABA Annual Meeting in August 2017 and expire at the conclusion of the 2019 ABA Annual Meeting.

The delegate must be willing to attend ABA mid-year and annual meetings or otherwise complete his/her term and responsibilities without reimbursement or compensation from the State Bar. However, the ABA provides reimbursement for expenses to attend the ABA mid-year meetings. Members who want to serve as the young lawyer delegate to the HOD must have been admitted to his or her first bar within the last five years or be less than 36 years old at the beginning of the term; be an ABA member in good standing throughout the tenure as a delegate; and report to the N.M. YLD Board during the YLD Board's scheduled board meetings throughout the tenure as a delegate.
