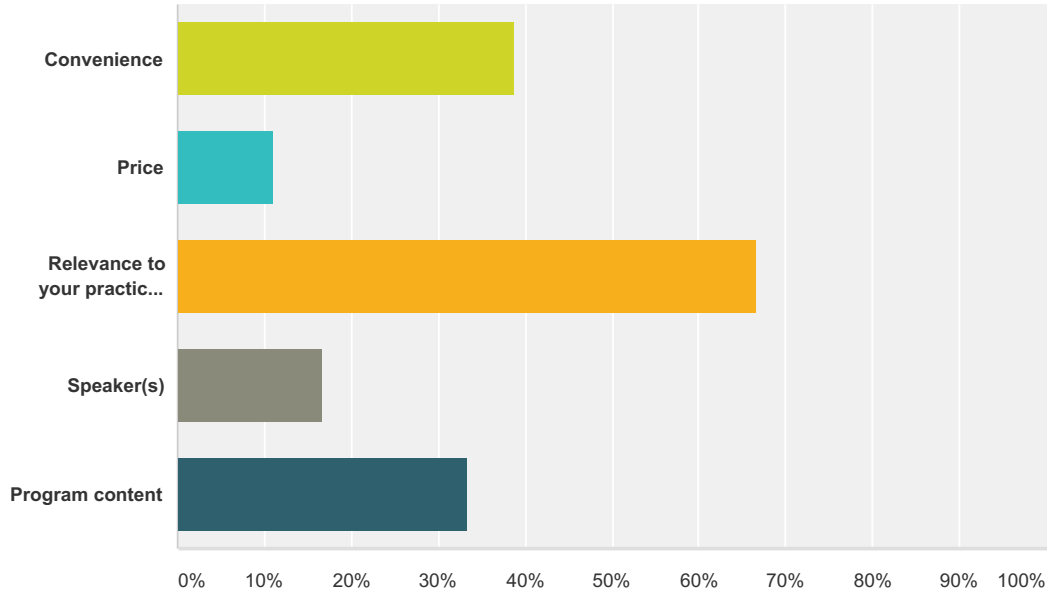


Q1 What factor was most important to you in deciding to attend the Representing Technology Start-ups in New Mexico CLE program?

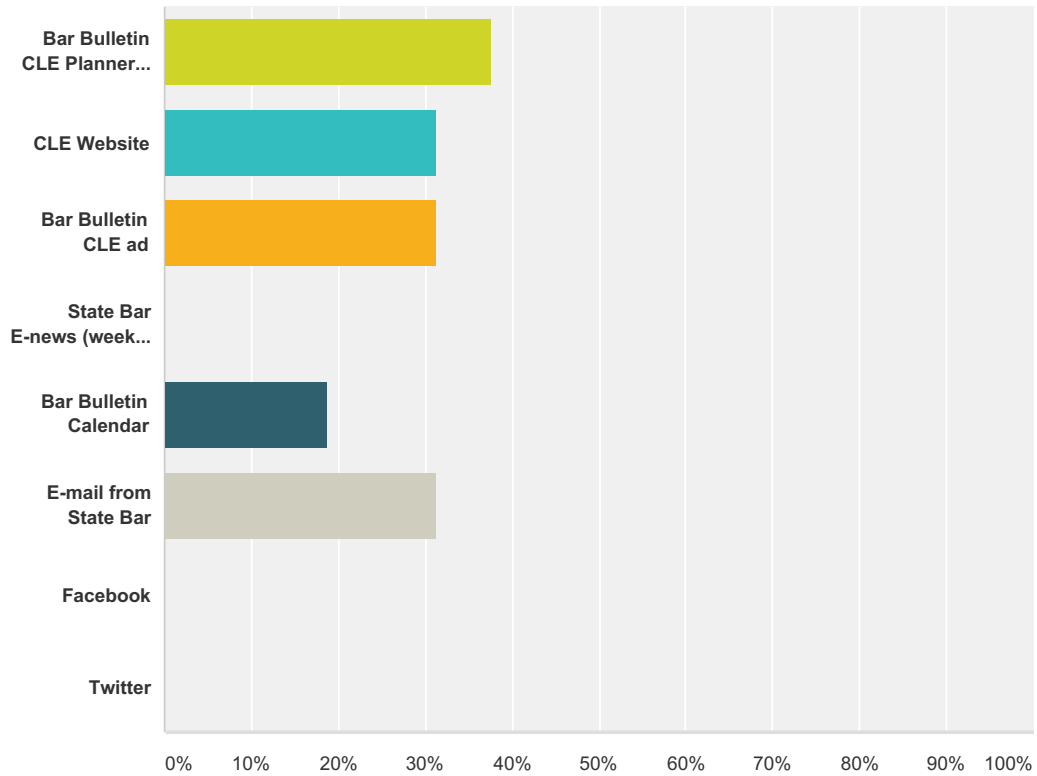

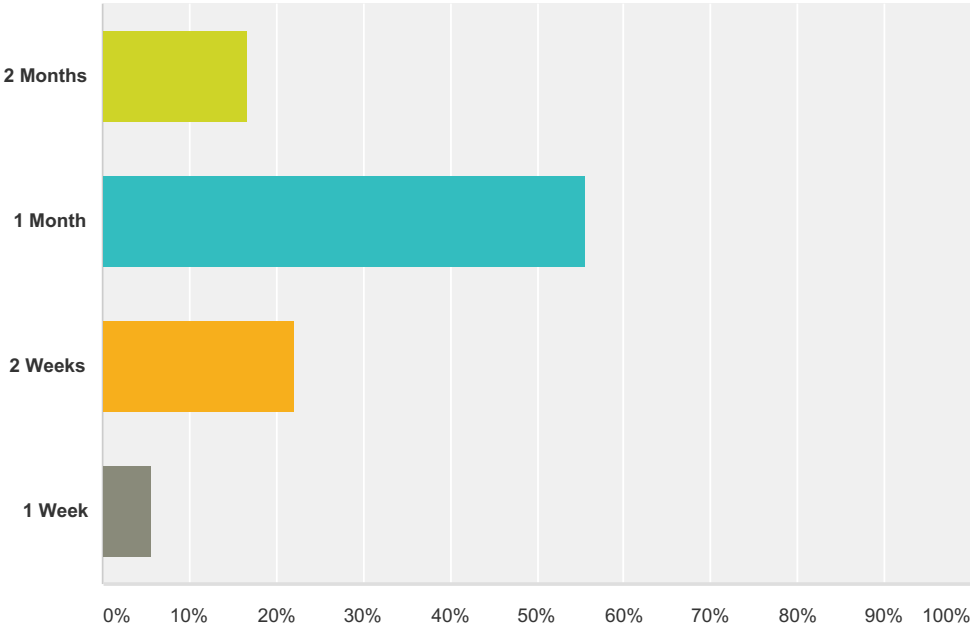

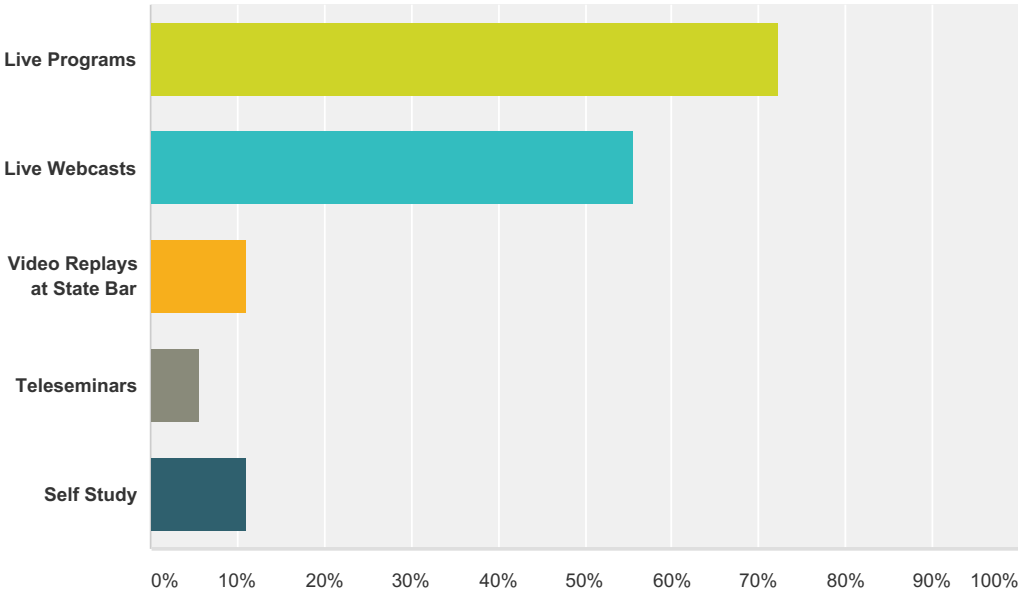

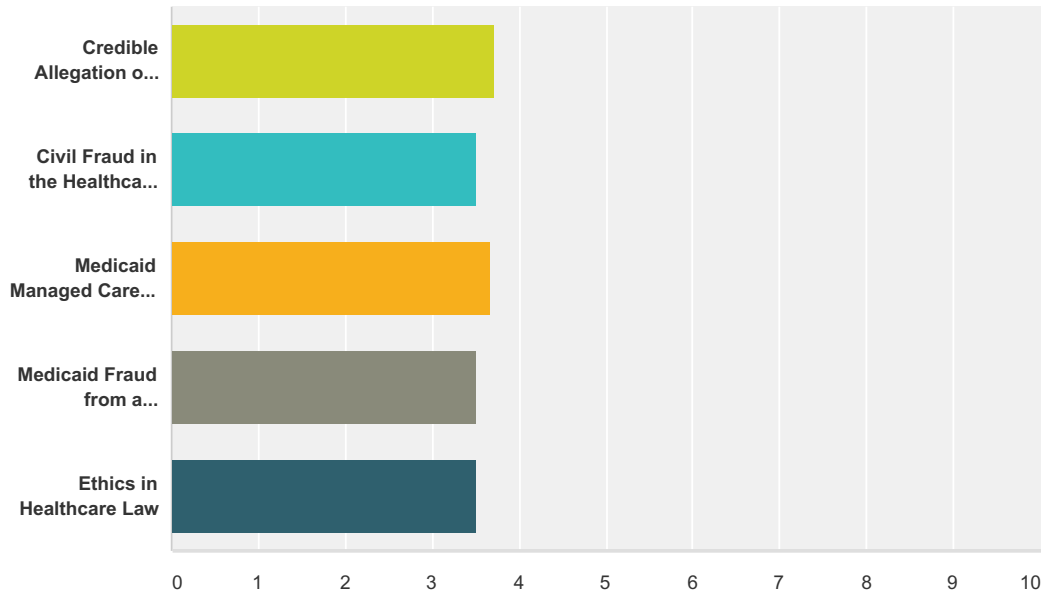

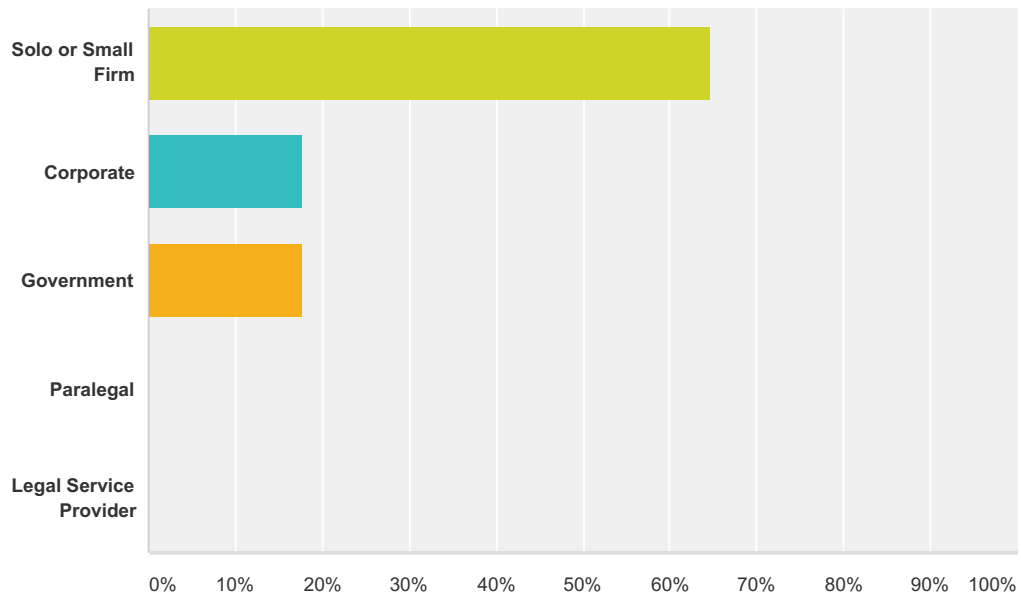

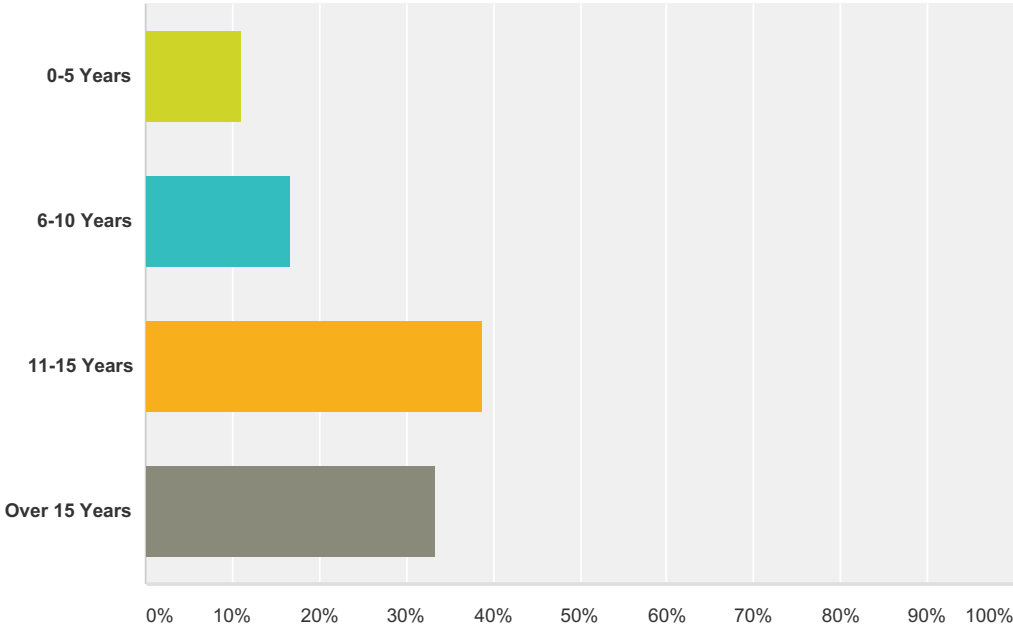

Q8 How many years have you been in your area of practice?

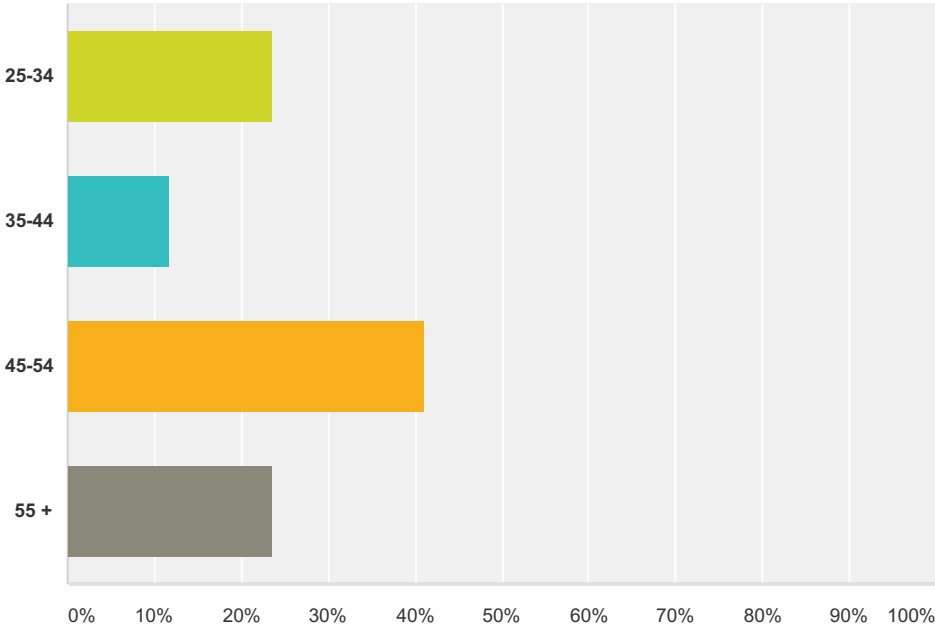
