

Risk Management Advisory Board

A summary of the duties of the advisory board, pursuant to §15-7-5 NMSA 1978, are to review: specifications for all insurance policies to be purchased by the risk management division; professional service and consulting contracts or agreements to be entered into by the division; insurance companies and agents to submit proposals when insurance is to be purchased by negotiation; rules and regulations to be promulgated by the division; certificates of coverage to be issued by the division; and investments made by the division.
